This boating/jetski safety course is designed to teach you to boat/jetski safely and enjoyably. When you finish this course you will feel more comfortable and confident about your boating/jetski activities. With this knowledge, you can avoid problems and enhance your enjoyment of your on-the-water activities.

Topics Covered:

Introduction to boating, navigation, boating laws, boating problems, personal safety equipment, trailering, storing & protecting your boat, safe boat handling, hunting & fishing, water skiing & river boating, parts of a boat/jetski, marine safety, what to do in an emergency and much more.

This course is **REQUIRED** for anyone in NY State who wishes to operate a personal water craft (PWC – jetski, wave runner, etc.). This class is also **REQUIRED** for children under the age of 18 who wish to operate a boat without adult supervision. Anyone who wishes to operate a boat safely should also be taking this course. This is an excellent course for a refresher for those who have some experience as well. **This course satisfies the NY State Boating Law requiring boating education for boat owners / users.**
