Mandated training

Members will not be eligible for ID cards or will not be able to hold an office (appointed or elected) until all courses are completed and entered into AUXDATA. Also, members will be placed into REYR status at the end of 2016 for all certifications they hold if all the Mandated Training is not complete.
